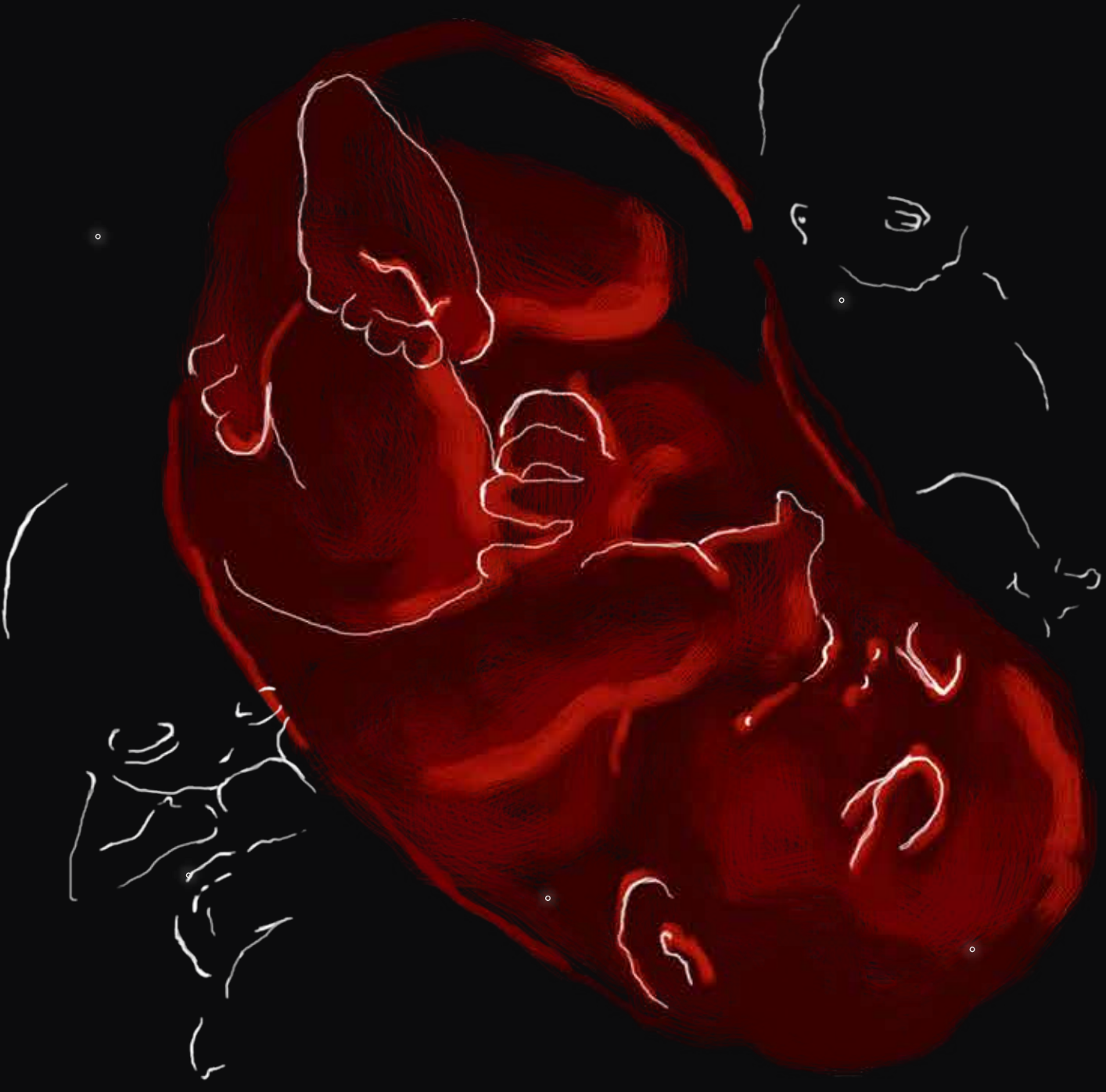

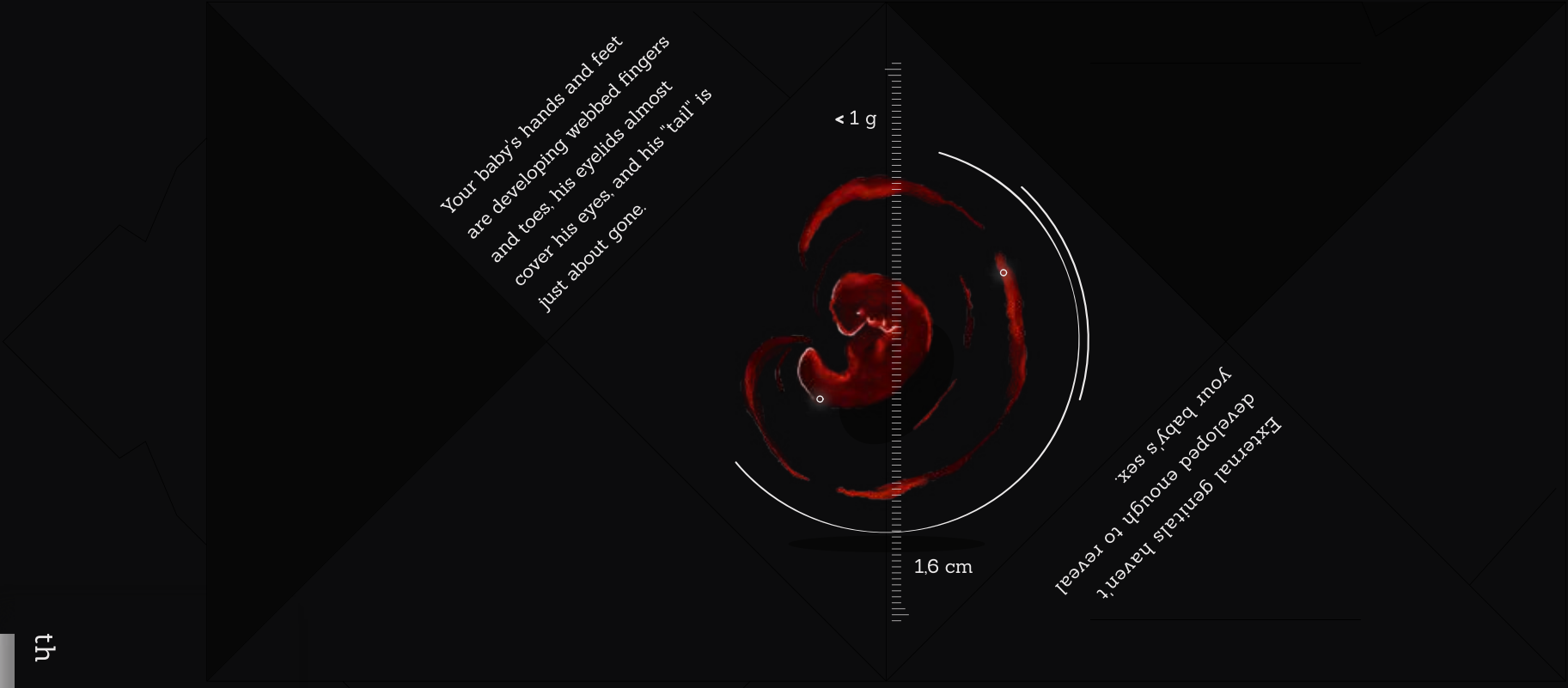

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Your baby's hands and feet are developing webbed fingers and toes, his eyelids almost cover his eyes, and his "tail" is just about gone.

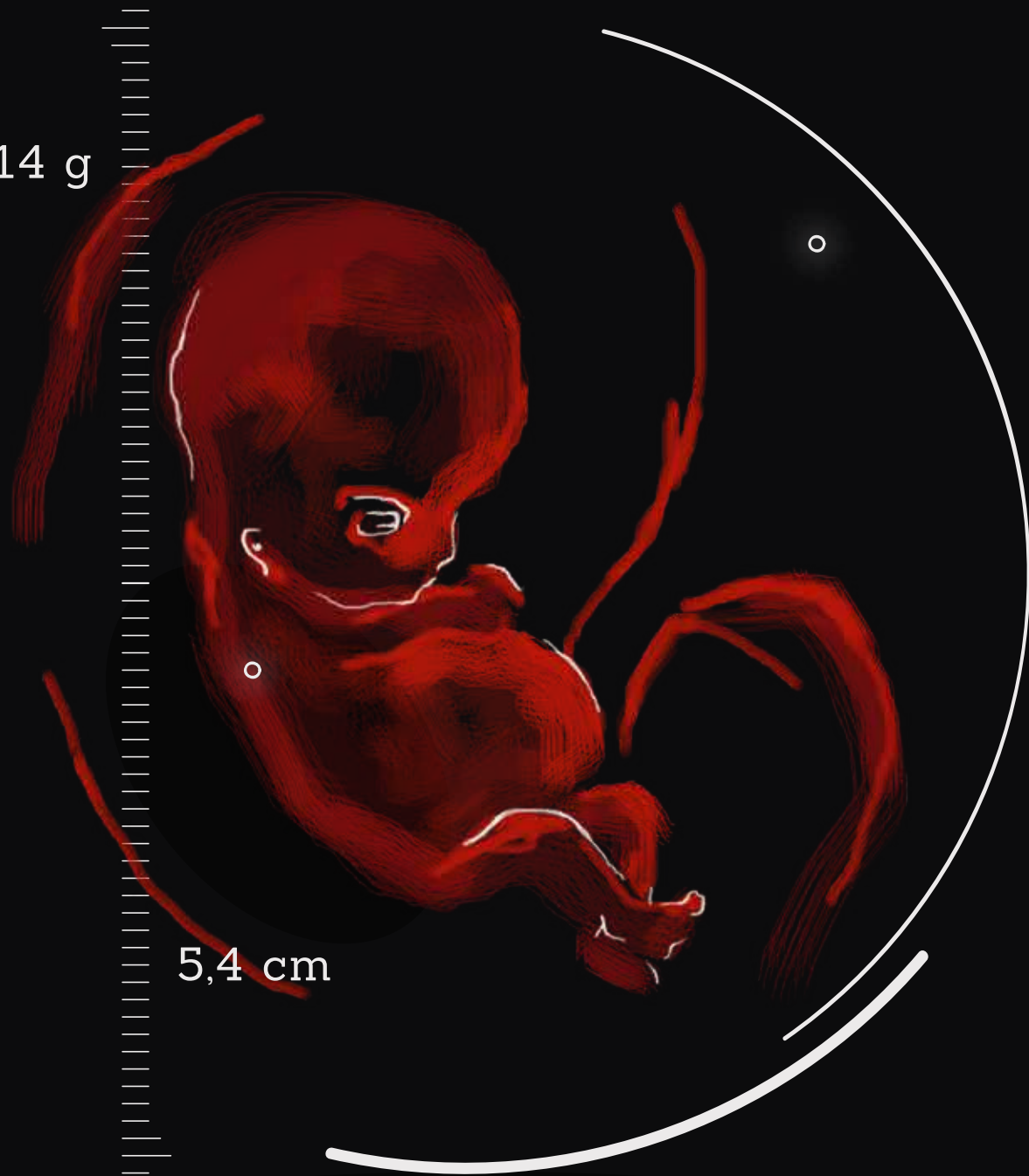
External genitals haven't developed enough to reveal your baby's sex.

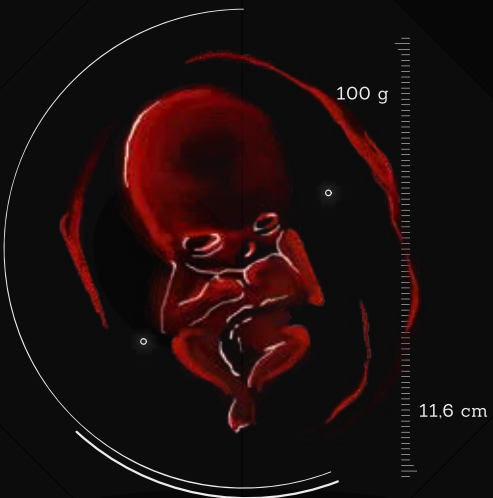

**By 18 weeks, an ultrasound technician should be able to identify the sex.**

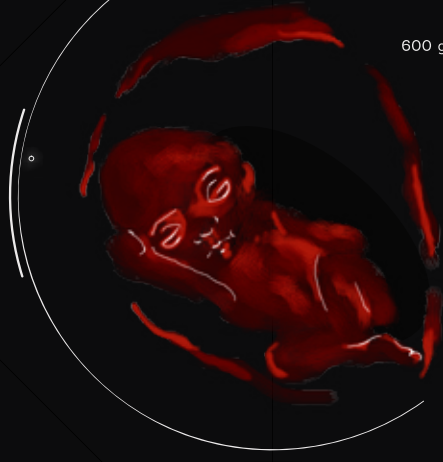
His legs are much more developed, and his head is more erect than it has been.

His lungs are developing "branches" of the respiratory "tree" as well as substance that will help his air sacs inflate once he hits the outside world.



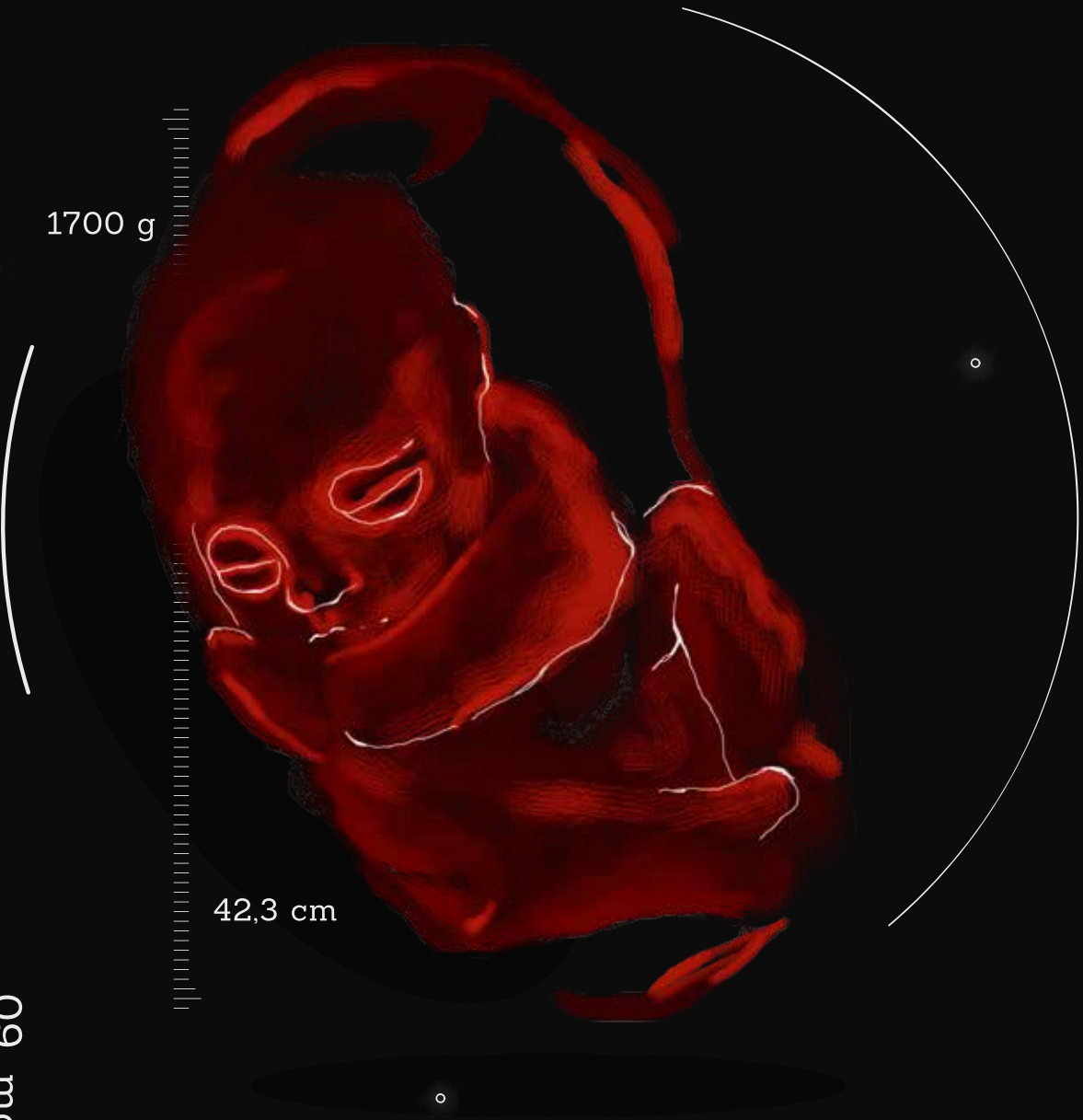
His skin is still thin and translucent, but that will start to change soon.

She's also developing billions of neurons in her brain and adding more body fat in preparation for life in the outside world.



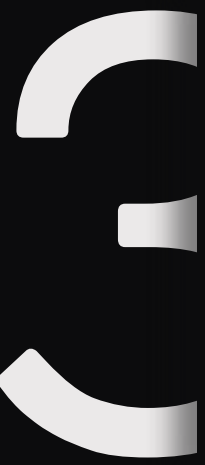

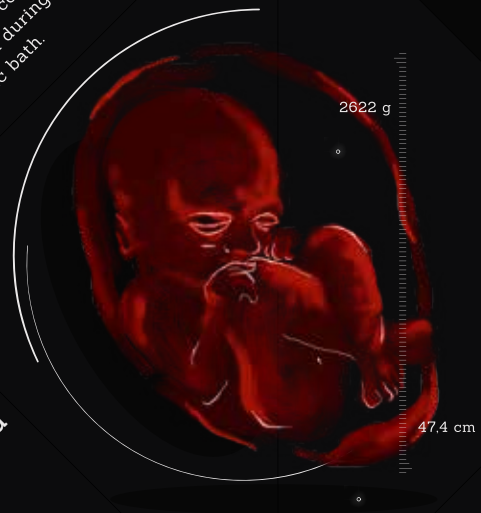

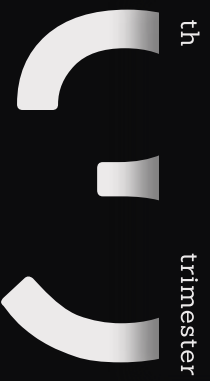


At the end of this week, your baby will be considered "early term."
